Make a Joyful Noise!

God's Word repeatedly exhorts us to "sing unto the Lord!" Psalms 33:3 says "Sing unto him a new song; play skillfully with a loud noise". Singing was a very prominent part of worship in the Old Testament. Solomon's songs numbered 1,005. David had a choir of 288 voices. Worship in song also marked many of the historical achievements of Israel, such as Moses and the children of Israel crossing the Red Sea, and David and all Israel bringing up of the ark of God. Matthew 26:30 says that Jesus and His disciples sang when gathered together. The early church also knew the power of praising God in song, as affirmed in Acts 2:46 and Ephesians 5:19. Revelation 5:9, 14:3, and 15:3 say this is what we will be doing for all eternity, so we better get some practice in now!

Whether by the use of instruments or song, music is a very scriptural means of expression towards God, and all are welcome at Enon Baptist Church to join in, either through congregational singing, playing an instrument, or by joining the choir.
